



Rouyn-Noranda, April 7, 2003. Jean-Marie Dupont, chairman of the Board of Directors of **Radisson Mining Resources Inc. (*Radisson*)** announces the departure of Guy Parent as president of the Company, and the appointment of Donald Lacasse, P.Eng., as his replacement.

Guy Parent, *Radisson's* president and CEO since 1996, is leaving for personal reasons. He is being replaced immediately by Donald Lacasse, who has been a member of the Board of Directors for 7 months. Mr. Lacasse is a civil engineer by training and has extensive experience in management. One member of the Board of Directors is Dale Hendrick, a recognized engineer in the mining field, who will directly support Mr. Lacasse as technical advisor.

Mr. Dupont would like to inform all the shareholders that the surface program planned for the O'Brien property is entering the final preparation phase and that the drilling and stripping work on zone 36 East should begin at the end of the spring.

Mr. Dupont wants to reiterate that the main asset of the Company, the O'Brien property, is located in the heart of the Cadillac gold camp. It is one of the most important mining camps in Canada, and continues to be impressive with Agnico Eagle Mines' recent discoveries at great depth on the Lapa-Cadillac property, a few kilometres further east on the same horizon as the O'Brien and Kewagama properties. This drilling discovery already contains a gold resource of 800,000 ounces between 500 and 1000 metres of vertical depth (see AGE's press release of February 19, 2003 and appended figure).

Radisson is a Canadian mining exploration company that specializes mainly in the exploration and development of gold and base metal projects with a view to becoming a producer. The Company is the sole owner or has interests in eleven properties in northeastern Québec, the large Abitibi mining region, whose most advanced property is approaching the development stage and contains a major gold resource of indicated category totaling 654,100 metric tons at a grade of 6.90 g/mt. The Company also has a gold concentrator of a capacity of 180 metric tons per day on its O'Brien property in Cadillac. The other properties contain geological contexts suitable for gold and base metal mineralization.
