

***e*Research Initiates Coverage on Radisson Mining Resources Inc.**

- ▶ The shares are recommended as a Speculative Buy with a 12-month Target Price of \$0.45.

- ▶ Recent NI 43-101 Technical Report on Zone 36 East on the O'Brien Property establishes a mineral resource and indicates excellent expansion potential.
- ▶ There are recognizable large gold mines in the vicinity, eg., Agnico Eagle's La Ronde
- ▶ Molybdenum properties in Ontario have attractive exploration potential and provide commodity diversity.
- ▶ The Company requires additional funding to carry out its exploration program.
- ▶ Low liquidity of Company's stock; small market cap.
- ▶ Low investor awareness of Company and its potential.
